## Order and Entry

Effective immediately arraignments at the Franklin County Clerk of Court's office, commonly referred to as "walk up arraignments" are subject to the following restrictions:

1. The Defendant must be present.

- 2. An Assistant County Prosecutor's signature is required. Defense counsel will be allowed to sign for the Assistant County Prosecutor if counsel has verbal authorization to do so.
- 3. Arraignment at the Clerk's Office must not occur later than 24 hours prior to the scheduled arraignment.

It is therefore ORDERED that the Franklin County Clerk of Court's office shall not process arraignments at their offices unless all of the above requirements have been satisfied.
