Arena District Rebounds with Return of Blue Jackets

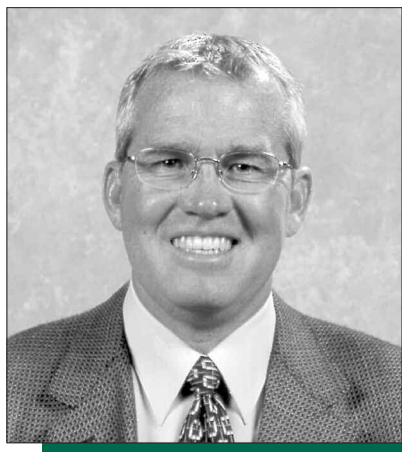

On July 22 of this year, the National Hockey League's Board of Governors ratified the terms of the Collective Bargaining Agreement negotiated with the NHL Players' Association, ending a 310-day work stoppage, ensuring the League will resume play for the 2005-06 season.
