# **Eminent Domain: Economic Tool** or Development Tyranny

For decades eminent domain has been used to build highways and stadiums and to reinvent "blighted" places. The U.S. Supreme Court established in 1968 that eminent domain can be used for economic development and reaffirmed that decision again in 1984. Both of these cases dealt with blighted properties.

In June of 2005 the U.S. Supreme Court issued its decision on Kelo v. New London recasting the debate on the use of this powerful local government tool in non-blighted circumstances. This set off a firestorm of media speculation nationwide. Can the government take your home and give it to Wal-Mart? Is the Kelo decision evidence of government run amok or does it reveal an obsolete economic system? This forum will explore the causes of and the solutions to taking property for economic development purposes. How far is too far and is enough being done in Ohio to protect private property rights?
