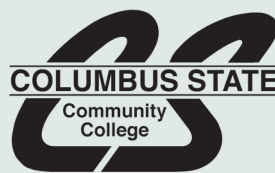
As a voluntary association of 42 government entities serving Ohio, MORPC is a catalyst for regional change through planning, programming and brokerage services in the
