New Model for Downtown Living: Gay Street Condos - "One Neighborhood"

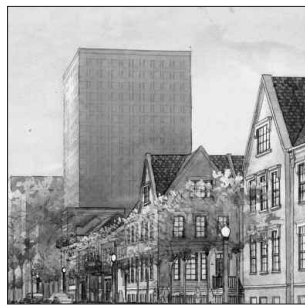
Jeff Edwards, President, Edwards Companies.

One of the city's boldest developers, Jeff Edwards is spearheading the latest in the Edwards Companies' out-of-the-box projects: 260 low rise housing units planted on fields of asphalt parking lots bordered by Gay and Long Streets between Fourth and Sixth. Construction has already begun on the \$100 million community "One Neighborhood," which will feature more than a dozen styles of condos and townhouses accented with extensive green space and private parking for residents. With some units expected to be available as early as 2008, prices will range from \$140,000 to \$650,000, considerably less than others in the downtown neighborhoods.

When Edwards began to think about jumping into the current downtown housing market, he decided to go out rather than up, gathering nine acres of parking lots from 11 owners rather than taking on a vacant office building. Edwards says himself that he doesn't know if he's "forward thinking or a risk taker."

But, risk taking is nothing new for the Edwards family. Whether envisioning "The Brewery District" where only blocks of forlorn and forgotten warehouses sat locked in time or parenting the state's first privately-funded freeway exit to create Tuttle Crossing, the Edwards Companies thrive on vision, imagination, creativity . . . and risk.
