What's an "experimental forum?"

For several months WOSU General Manager and CMC Board Member Tom Rieland has championed a group of CMC members to create one forum that will experiment with an entirely different forum format. On March 12, the Experimental Forum Committee hosts a CMC World Café discussion on City Center's future.

A well-known and widely-used format, World Café is a creative process in a café setting. CMC will transform the banquet hall at the Athletic Club into a café setting, where attendees will enjoy a generous box lunch while discussing two questions relative to the future of City Center.

Café tables of four covered with butcher paper provide the blank canvas to capture thoughts, ideas, drawings, and questions. Participants will move from table to table cross pollinating ideas and gathering new information.

The Committee will assemble notes from the forum into a white paper, which will be delivered to Mayor Michael Coleman, members of Columbus City Council and the Columbus Downtown Development Corporation.
