Over the last several years and now as Nationwide Children's Hospital, the organization has grown to become the nation's fifth largest children's hospital, sixth largest pediatric research center and a magnet for world-class physicians and scientists.

In July 2006, Steve Allen assumed the role as CEO of Nationwide Children's Hospital where he is charged with leading the hospital's aggressive plan to become one of the nation's premiere pediatric institutions. Dr. Allen will share with the Columbus Metropolitan Club his vision for the future of Nationwide Children's Hospital and how he has been leading transformational change at the hospital.

Education, research and clinical care are traditionally seen as the three legs that support academic medicine. In addition to pursuing advances in all these areas, Dr. Allen has also focused his team's attention improving the well being of all children in the community.

He will share some findings from a new collaborative pediatric healthcare report prepared by Nationwide Children's, the Columbus Public Health Department and other agencies which details the most significant public health indicators impacting children in Franklin County, including the number one public health threat for the next generation: obesity.
