Don't miss this once in a lifetime opportunity to get up close and personal with a 161 ton KC-135 Stratotanker. While you'll only get to tour the plane at our On-Site, those who attend may be considered for future orientation flights.*

The Stratotanker's principal mission is air refueling support to U.S. Air Force, U.S. Navy, U.S. Marine Corps and allied aircraft. Its cargo deck is also used to transport cargo and passengers.

The 121st Air Refueling Wing is one of 88 Air National Guard flying units in the United States, four of which are in Ohio. Its primary mission is to provide aerial refueling to U.S. Air Force, Navy and Marine Corps, and allied aircraft. Located at Rickenbacker International Airport, the 121st performs worldwide refueling and transport missions on a daily basis.

Following a briefing by Brig. General Thomas M. Botchie, commander of the 121st Air Refueling Wing, you'll tour the country's foremost refueling aircraft and its support facilities.

You'll also get an opportunity to learn more about the Employer Support of Guard and Reserve.



* Orientation flights are provided at the sole discretion of the 121st Refueling Wing and the strict selection process administered by their command team.
