Davis has been Chief Executive Officer at Bob Evans Farms Inc. since 2006. He inherited a company that was, by most analysts' opinions, in poor shape. Same store sales had been falling steadily for two years, and many restaurants had already closed. The company had seen profits fall eight out of nine quarters prior to the resignation of the company's previous CEO, and net income had fallen 48% from the previous year.

"When I met all the people and looked at the historical performance, I realized these are good people. They just needed a rudder," Davis told Smart Business. "They needed somebody to come in and say, 'Let's see what we can do.'"


