Military Advisory Board Report on Climate and Energy Security


In the last two years, CNA's* Military
Advisory Board, a blue ribbon panel of top-
ranking retired admirals and generals, has
released two groundbreaking reports that
outline the multifaceted nature of a new and
unprecedented national security threat
posed by climate change and the United
States' energy posture. *National Security and
the Threat of Climate Change*
(securityandclimate.cna.org) and *Powering
America's Defense: Energy and the Risk to
National Security*
(www.PoweringAmericasDefense.org), each
the result of a year-long study, were
prompted by the military practice of
anticipating threats and strategically
planning for America's security.

After carefully considering the threat of
climate change and current energy
consumption to U.S. national security, the
CNA Military Advisory Board finds the
trends and warnings are clear.

Retired Vice Admiral Dennis McGinn
took the helm at RemoteReality in January,
2008 after five years with Battelle Memorial
Institute, where he was a corporate officer
and led the energy, transportation and
environment division.

Prior to joining Battelle, Admiral McGinn
served 35 years with the U.S. Navy as a naval
aviator, test pilot, aircraft carrier
commanding officer, and national security
strategist. His last assignment was Deputy
Chief of Naval Operations for Warfare
Requirements and Programs at the
Pentagon where he led the development of
the U.S.


