## Reporting from the Statehouse: Meet the Press

The proposed state budget,  
marriage equality, sweepstakes cafés,  
tax reform, education and more will be  
discussed by some of Columbus' top  
journalists from print, TV and radio at  
the CMC forum on Wednesday, April  
10. Consider this forum the flash-  
round of newsworthy, hotly-debated  
state policy with each topic weighty  
enough to merit an entire forum.

It's impossible to read the  
newspaper or listen to the news  
without finding facts and opinions  
about the Governor's proposed budget,  
which includes major revisions to the  
tax code. Ohio citizens and lobbyists  
are expressing concerns and support  
for extending sales tax to previously  
non-taxed services ranging from  
haircuts to legal services. The panel  
will weigh the pros and cons and  
perhaps, predict what changes will  
stick.

Education funding for both K-12  
and higher education is also a hot  
topic. Add curriculum standards,  
teacher/union compensation and  
evaluation and this issue becomes  
even more complicated and  
contentious. That doesn't even  
include recent controversy about  
Columbus City Schools' student

absence and test score reporting.

Political reporter at WBNS 10TV Jim  
Heath, will moderate CMC's version  
of Meet the Press. In addition to his  
television reporting, Heath frequently  
posts his views on Facebook. Panelist  
Bill Cohen, now celebrating his 40th  
year reporting for Ohio's public news  
stations, recently announced his plans  
to retire from the Statehouse News  
Bureau. His voice is an icon on local  
and national stations when news from  
the Ohio Statehouse hits the airwaves.

Heath (WBNS 10TV) and Colleen  
Marshall (NBC 4) compete for the  
Sunday morning ratings with their  
own locally-produced political made-  
for-television roundtable discussions,  
but they readily share the stage to  
bring their unique insight to the CMC  
audience. Dispatch columnist Joe  
Hallett adds his in-depth perspectives  
about Ohio issues, key players and  
probably outcomes as only Joe can.

Since Ohio proved once-again to  
hold the swing-state title, policies  
coming from our state catch the  
interest of national political leaders  
and pundits. Learn what interests  
the journalists. "Tune in" for  
diverse discussion from these four  
quintessential political news sources.
