The Entrepreneurs' Organization's Global Entrepreneur Indicator report taps into the minds of the world's leading business owners to identify trends in the global economy... and then, compares them to Columbus.

For example, the report just released shows that 61.4% of Columbus businesses increased their bottom line in the past six months compared to only 59.81% of entrepreneurs globally. Nearly 72% of Columbus businesses increased their number of full time employees in the past six months, compared to only 61% globally.
