21st Century Caliphate - ISIS Crisis

Syria, Iraq and other Middle East countries are a powder keg with a burning fuse that has explosive political implications regionally and globally. It's complicated, historical, threatening and nearly impossible for the average person to understand.

To help sort out the issues, CMC is offering "21st Century Caliphate - The Isis Crisis" on Wednesday, October 29, featuring Dr. Alam Payind, director of Middle East Studies Center at Ohio State University, since 1986. A native of Afghanistan, Payind previously held government and academic positions in Kabul and speaks Pashto, Dari and Urdu with native fluency. He continues to conduct field work and provide consultations on a regular basis in Afghanistan. Patrick Terrien, executive director of the Columbus Council on World Affairs will discuss the ISIS threat with Pavind.

A caliphate is a political-religious territory led by a Muslim leader (The Caliph). Following the death of Muhammad there have been many

Caliphate leaders or movements in territories centered in the Middle East and at times extending from today's Turkey, to eastern Russian following around the southern Mediterranean coast to the northern Africa. Will the most recent iteration of a new Caliphate the Islamic State of Syria and Iraq? The power and rule of ISIS or ISIL has not been accepted by all Muslims in Syria, Iraq and nearby countries, leading to violence and unrest.

Although the US has been involved in airstrikes against the Islamic State for a couple months, it was only last week that the Pentagon announced that the military operation in Iraq was given the name "Inherent Resolve." As reported in the Washington Post, The U.S. Central command explained that "The name Inherent Resolve is intended to reflect the unwavering resolve and deep commitment of the U.S. and partner nations in the region and around the globe to eliminate the terrorist group ISIS, and the threat they pose to Iraq, the region and the wider international community."






