Join us on YouTube and Facebook to revisit this discussion and share your thoughts about how the world has changed in the three-and-a-half years since this forum originally took place.

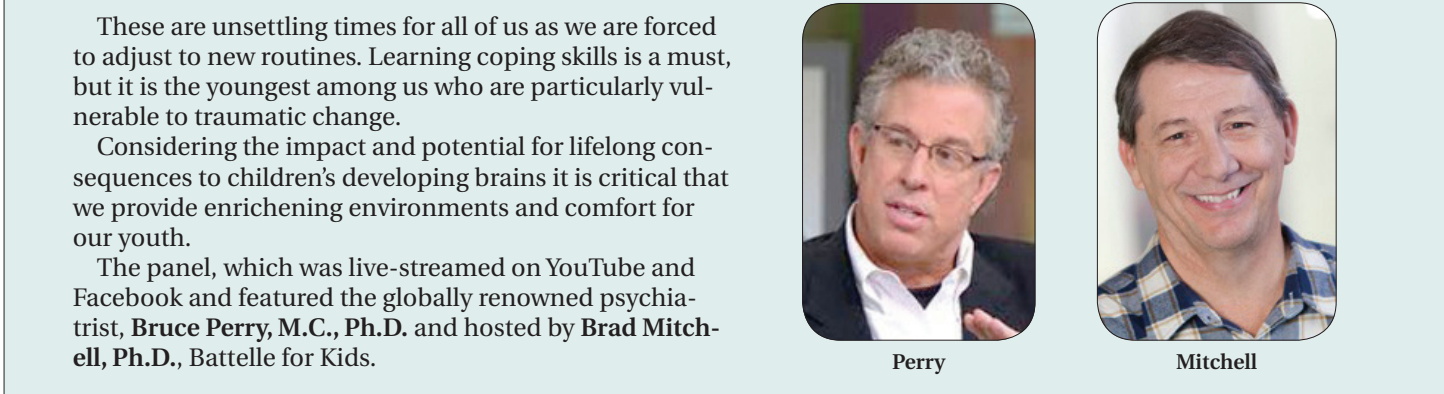
