Special Report: Battelle and OSU Wexner Medical Center Create Innovative Solutions

Two benevolent giants live side by side in our community. Battelle and OSU Wexner Medical Center. When our community was in crisis, they joined forces to help, as have done many times in the past.

The story of the dire need for N95 protective masks for medical professionals and how Battelle quickly adapted technology to decontaminate masks became national news in March when Gov. Mike DeWine petitioned the president directly to speed up FDA approval. Battelle now has 60 decontamination sites across the country with 36 fully operational, capable of decontaminating millions of masks per day nationwide.

As one of America's topranked academic health centers, the OSU Wexner Medical Center's mission to improve people's lives through innovation in research, education and patient care has perhaps never been more intensely demonstrated. Innovations in safety practices for patients, guests, employees,

and medical professionals, telehealth appointments, expanded COVID-19 testing and treatment, 3-D printed swabs, and a plethora of information channels are just a few innovative new strategies to address community needs.

For example, an Ohio State research team responded overnight to develop a crucial new viral transport media for testing kits. "We're fortunate to have the scientists and the resources at Ohio State's seven health

sciences colleges and across campus to create these vital materials and to be able to serve other hospital systems in Ohio and around the country that need them," said Dr. **Hal Paz**, executive vice president and chancellor for Health Affairs at Ohio State and CEO of the Ohio State Wexner Medical Center. "This is what Buckeyes do. We collaborate to solve society's biggest problems. We're all in this together."
