Columbus was on a roll, with Experience Columbus reporting record convention and visitor business at its annual meeting on March 4. Attendees that night were shocked, confused and skeptical to learn that that very day Governor Mike DeWine had closed the Arnold Classic exhibition and forbade spectators at the competitions. WHAT?

Looking back, general wisdom agrees that dramatic and gutsy decision saved hundreds, possibly thousands of COVID-19 cases for the city and the Arnold attendees from around the country and globe.

Little did anyone know that was just the beginning of what would be a bloodbath for the travel and tourism industry, hotels, restaurants, bars, airlines..... Experience Columbus reported since the outbreak, 37 groups have canceled events in Columbus that would have meant 86,000 room nights and \$74

million in spending. Ironically, opening night for “My Fair Lady,” was also CAPA’s closing night of public performances, as the next day the Governor limited gatherings to no more than 10 people. Theaters and museums closed.

When will CMC Return to Live Audiences at the Boat House?

That’s the \$64,000 question, isn’t it? And, it’s a question that I get multiple times a day as my team and I work remotely, orchestrate weekly Livestreaming forums and pray that our members and sponsors will continue supporting us.

While Livestreaming our forums has “kept the conversation going,” and drawn an entirely new audience of thousands for CMC, we long to also have live audiences, albeit perhaps smaller than our former 220-person average.

Last Wednesday May 13, I met with Ed Reynoso, General Manager of the Boat House, Asst. Director of Special Events Regina Myers and Executive Chef Zoltan. They are consulting with the Ohio Department of Health to clarify guidelines for banquet facilities.

As part of the national chain of Specialty Restaurants, the Boat House is im-

plementing significant safety and sanitation standards throughout the system.

- Electronic thermometer readings of guests at entry
- All employees will wear facemasks, servers will wear gloves
- Signage to encourage physical distancing
- Multiple hand sanitation stations throughout the facility

- installation of touchless faucets and soap dispensers in restrooms
- All doors remain open whenever possible
- Opening and Closing machine (mist) sanitation
- Multiple-times-per-day sanitizing handles, door-knobs, public surfaces
- Extensive staff training in COVID-19 specifically, and

“serve safe,” with mandatory adherence

Additionally, for CMC forums, we will require guests to wear face masks except during dining. Dining room numbers will be limited, with tables seating three – four guests. Paper napkins, no bread service, no coffee and cookies following the forum, pre-dressed salads with a single plated meal. Name tags will be the annoying sticky label ones!

Details could change, but this is what we know now. If you have questions, ideas, concerns, please share them with us. We are eager to see you but will be watching how COVID-19 numbers look over the first few weeks as restaurants and businesses reopen before we make a decision to bring folks back to CMC forums.

Until then, thank you for tuning in via livestreaming. We will continue livestreaming forums indefinitely.
