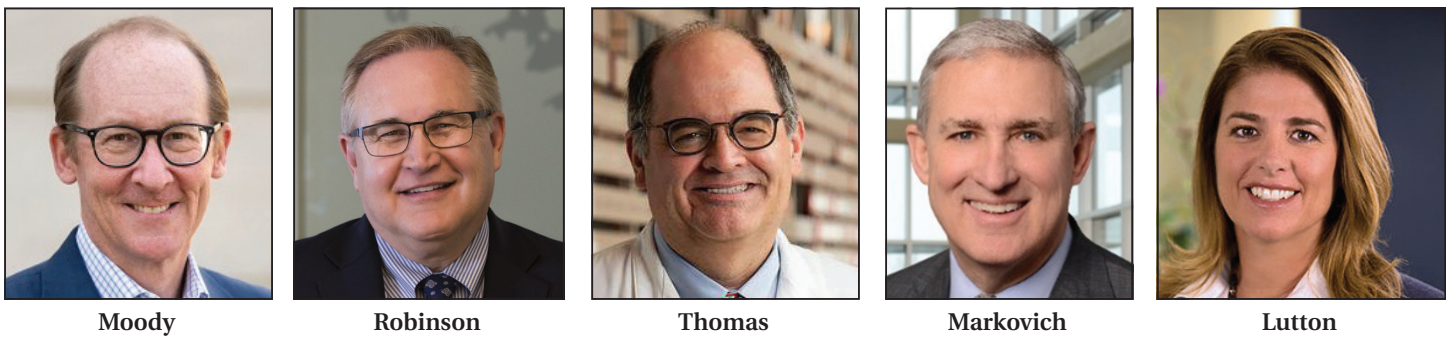

## Central Ohio Hospital CEO Roundtable



The COVID-19 pandemic has and is prompting hospitals to cooperate and coordinate in new ways. What did Central Ohio's hospital CEOs learn from the global pandemic? On June 8, the Columbus Metropolitan Club welcomes an extraordinary panel featuring the CEOs of all four Central Ohio hospital systems.

With COVID-19 shifting into an endemic phase, in which the disease persists but results in a reduced disruption to society, Ohio's healthcare systems will now need to continue to manage COVID while preparing for global pandemics of the future, which Sarah Gilbert, one of the scientists behind

the Oxford-AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccine, recently stated "could be worse" than COVID-19.

Central Ohio's population is also aging, with a corresponding rise in its healthcare consumption. Between 2010 and 2050, Franklin County's population of adults aged 60 and over is expected to double. Will Central Ohio's hospitals be prepared to handle the needs of an aging population in the decades to come? Will enough people choose healthcare careers to keep hospitals staffed?

While Ohio did choose to expand Medicaid in 2014, which helped low-income adults without dependent children join the govern-

ment-funded healthcare program, the cost of healthcare continues to rise. How will Ohioans pay for increasingly expensive care, and how can access to quality healthcare continue to expand?

To address these and other critical healthcare questions, moderator **Greg Moody**, Director of Professional Development and the State of Ohio Leadership Institute, will be joined onstage by **Timothy Robinson**, Chief Executive Officer, Nationwide Children's Hospital, **Andrew Thomas**, M.D., Interim Co-Leader and Chief Clinical Officer and Senior Associate Vice President for Health Sciences, The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center, **Stephen Markovich**,

M.D., President and Chief Executive Officer, OhioHealth, and **Lorraine Lutton**, President and Chief Executive Officer, Mount Carmel Health System.

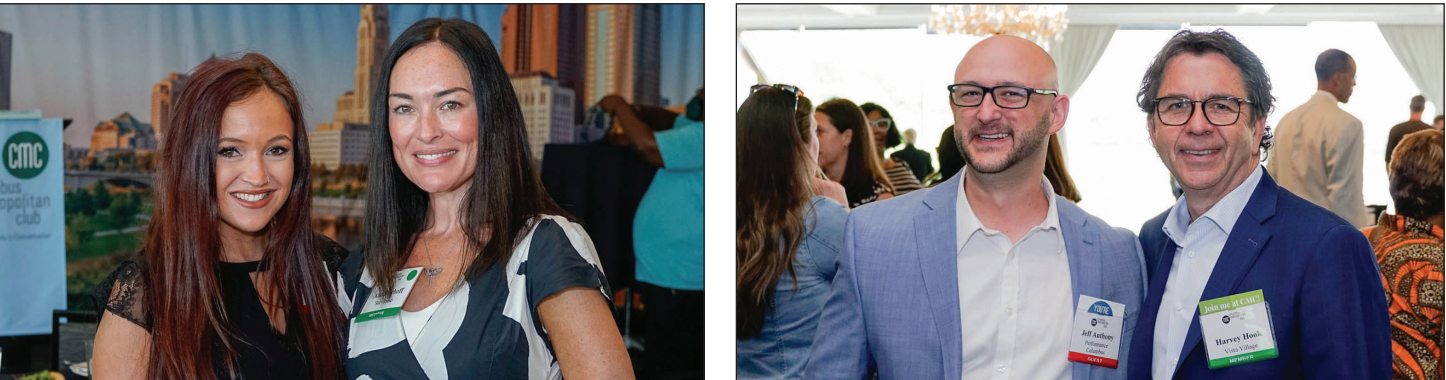
